To bring you up to date, Boys State is a program of the American Legion where students between their Junior and Senior year of high school spend one week in Tallahassee acting as State and Local Government officials. They assume the duties of the positions that they are elected to in a "fictitious" state for the week, using the facilities of State Capitol, House and Senate chambers State Supreme Court chambers and other facilities within the State

Capitol complex as needed and available. They will be learning local government operations from the city, county and state levels throughout the week. Two candidates will be chosen from all of the attendees to go on to a similar event at Boys Nation in Washington, DC. Usually, they are welcomed by the actual Governor at the beginning of the week. Each candidate is asked to write a "bill" on something that is a concern of his and present it through the legislature. Bills that are passed through for the youth governor to sign are often passed on the State Legislature for consideration at the next session.

You could be helping to select our future leaders, so let me know if you are available on February 25<sup>th</sup>.

## School Medals—Bob Colbert

Post 112 presents school medals to several elementary schools, high schools and the University of Central Florida Army ROTC each year. Last year, the Post presented medals to five elementary schools, one high school, UCF's Army ROTC and one JROTC. We also recognize two members of the Centurion Battalion's Sea Cadets. It is a morale booster and provides recognition to the students.

It isn't really a difficult task; we provide a recommended script to each "presenter" so there isn't much that our Legionnaire needs to do other than be at the presentation. The number we can present is limited by the number of volunteers (members) that are willing to make presentations. In the past we have presented medals to twelve elementary schools, two middle schools, one private school, two high school JROTCs and two high schools.

The problem that we have is that Seminole County Schools all want to present their medals on the same day. And Orange County Schools all want to present their medals on the same day, different from Seminole County day. In order to service all the schools that we want to, we need 6 to 8 presenters available on the dates given.

At each school, we present a Citizenship medal to one boy and one girl. The ROTC, JROTC and the Centurion Battalion get two medals each but for Scholastic Achievement and Military Excellence. As you can see, one person or even two cannot handle this load. That is why I am looking for assistance now, in advance of the May-June timeframe when the medals are presented.

Please let the Adjutant know if you think that you can help. We don't have the exact dates yet, but they are traditionally in the last week of May or the first week of June. The ROTC, JROTC and Sea Cadets hold their ceremonies earlier in the year. Hopefully, this can give you enough information to plan.
